- District and Foundation completed and submitted the required payment to receive the \$10,000 donation. As of May 20, Avangrid Renewables is going through its internal processes and working toward rapid remittance.

Subject: CVHIP Marketing Campaign and COVID-19 Activities Update

Staff Recommendation: Informational item only.

Marketing Campaign Update

- On March 24, 2020, the Desert Healthcare District and Foundation Board of Directors approved implementing a digital marketing campaign to inform and engage with Coachella Valley residents about CVHIP.com
- The 10-month campaign began April 15, 2020, and consists of English and Spanish ads via KESQ TV, Telemundo TV, La Poderosa Radio, KESQ's, and Telemundo's websites, Facebook and Instagram, and geo-targeting locations.
- Digital ads were launched on KESQ's and Telemundo's websites the week of April 14 and radio spots followed on April 23. Social media and TV advertising are being reviewed by staff and are expected to begin the week of April 27.
- In addition to the KESQ and Telemundo marketing efforts, smaller media outlets like El Informador del Valley and the Uken Report have launched ads to inform the public of CVHIP.com.

Analytics

- The utilization of CVHIP.com has seen a significant increase from an average of 600 to 1,400 monthly users since the launch of the marketing campaign (4/15 to 5/15).
- The most common searched terms are:
 - Food (65%)
 - Money (23%)
 - \circ Housing (8%)

COVID-19 Response Activities Update

- The CVHIP search engine was enhanced by adding COVID-19; COVID-19 Control and COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing to the taxonomy to assist community members seeking COVID-19 specific programs/services.
- A comprehensive list of COVID-19 resources and information has been placed on both the English and Spanish CVHIP landing page, which is updated weekly.

• IHEP awarded \$1,500 in technology grant awards to 7 local organizations to increase their technical capacity and continue to connect community members with much-needed resources using CVHIP.com

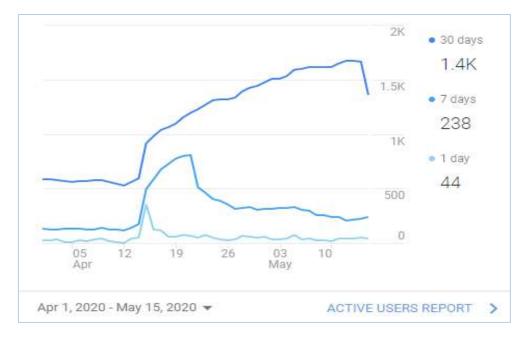

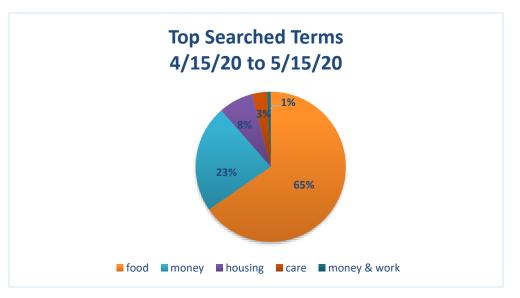

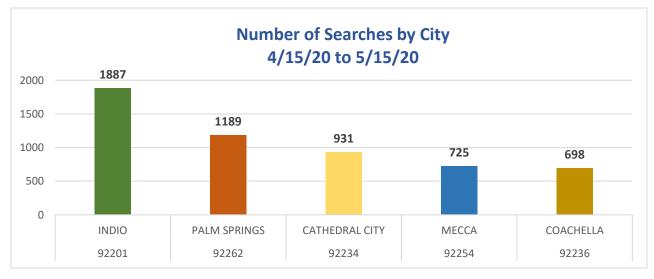

RESOLUTION NO. 20-03

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DESERT HEALTHCARE FOUNDATION SUPPORTING A DISTRICT-WIDE POLICY FOR USE OF DISTRICT AND FOUNDATION FUNDS

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of February 27, 2018, after robust discussion and public comment from government officials, residents, community-based organizations, provider organizations, and other stakeholders, the Board of Directors of the Desert Healthcare Foundation ("District"), approved Resolution No. 18-01 adopting a self-funded approach to provide \$300,000 per year for 20-years from District/Foundation unrestricted funds" to serve the Eastern Coachella Valley District in the event the expansion measure was successful and;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 18-01 does not allow for the use of restricted District funds from property tax revenues or facility replacement funds to be used to benefit the area of the proposed Eastern Coachella Valley District expansion and;

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018 Riverside County Measure BB which expanded the District boundaries and service area to include the Eastern Coachella Valley was overwhelmingly passed by over 80% of the voters; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2019 at a special meeting the Board of District, after a public interview process, the District Board appointed Directors DeLara and Borja to represent the newly expanded areas of the Eastern Coachella Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Foundation finds and declares that it serves the best interests of the Foundation and the communities served by the Foundation to formally support the action taken by the District Board of Directors in adopting Resolution No. 20-02 which allows the District to utilize all District funds (restricted and non-restricted) to address the mission of the District, and the health care needs of the residents of the entire District and communities served by the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Desert Healthcare Foundation as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Directors of the Foundation hereby supports the action taken by the Board of Directors in adopting Resolution No. 20-02 deleting the restriction that District funds from property tax revenues or facility replacement funds cannot be used to benefit the expanded area of the Eastern Coachella Valley and the Board of Directors of the Foundation hereby concurs with the adoption of a One-Coachella Valley approach which allows the District and the Foundation to utilize all District and Foundation funds to address the missions of the District and Foundation and the health care needs of the residents of the entire District and communities served by the District and Foundation. Section 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Board.
