Adjournment	Dr. Bárzaga, CEO, explained that staff is engaged in the meetings, and an update will be provided at the next Board meeting. Vice-President Borja inquired whether the cities are still matching the \$100k homelessness funds, and any additional updates. Dr. Bárzaga, CEO, explained that Greg Rodriguez will be requesting the funding through the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG), not the District. The District allocated funds to the collaborative, and Greg may use the funds through traditional resources with the cities. Director Rogers inquired about using the District and Foundation funds to support the cooling centers in Palm Springs and Desert Hot Springs since the county is not funding the centers this year. Further, Director Rogers questioned how the county expended the funding since the allocation was for the homelessness cooling centers. Dr. Baraza explained that a request through the grant process with the homelessness collaborative would be necessary for assistance with the cooling centers.
