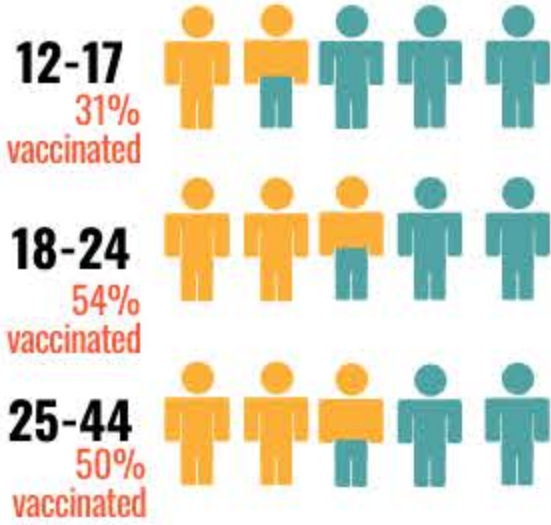
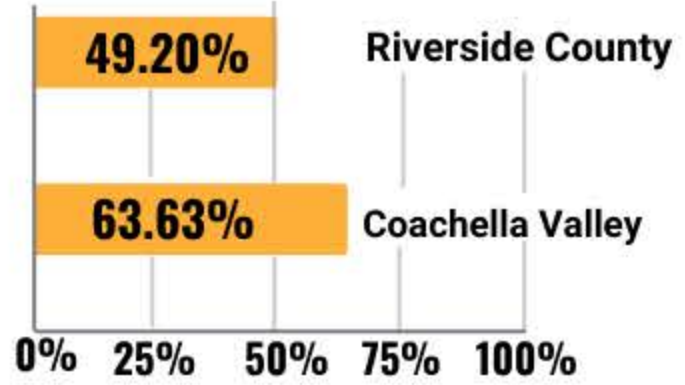


Coachella Valley Equity Collaborative on COVID-19 Response

Through a partnership with Riverside County and the Public Health Institute, the Desert Healthcare District and Foundation developed the Coachella Valley Equity Collaborative (CVEC) that awarded **\$3.1 million** to local organizations for COVID-19 response.
